Since our founding in 2013, the Belleair Community Foundation (BCF) has contributed over \$945,000 to the Town of Belleair, financing & managing 42 improvement projects that have dramatically enhanced the lives of our residents. Rallying through private & public partnerships, the BCF enables Belleair residents and town employees to enjoy an elevated sense of protection, recreation, park renewal, connectivity, pride, and community spirit that would not have otherwise been possible. 97% of funds raised by the BCF are contributed back to the community.

The BCF has designed, planned, and implemented comprehensive renovations of three Town of Belleair Parks, featuring custom-crafted memorials, water fountains, fine art sculptures, and an extensive palm tree planting. The BCF also provides the annual maintenance funding for these projects.

BCF funds have paved the way for Police Squad Room Renovations, a new Police Cruiser, Ballistic Police Vests, Flashlights, Radar Units, Radios and Bicycles.
